

Shapleigh Morris Drisko, served as President of the Derby-Shelton Rotary Club during Rotary year 1980-1981. He was born August 10, 1932 in Columbia Falls, Washington County, Maine the son of Clarence Holmes Drisko and Myra Mabel Morris. He was married to Barbara Lucille Barron also from Washington County, Maine. He was a veteran having graduated from The United States Military Academy at West Point in 1954 and served in Korea and Vietnam before retiring from active duty with the rank of Lieutenant Colonel.
